

<u>Open House Thursday October  $5^{\text{th}}$ , 6:00 – 7:00 pm</u> All families are invited to attend our Open House this Thursday from 6 – 7.

We will start in the gym at 5:45 for anyone wanting Child Abuse Protocol Training, which you must have every year in order to volunteer at the school.

At 6:00 we will welcome everyone into the gym and Stacy will give a **quick talk** about **how and why we** teach math the way we do, and simple things to do at home to support your kids with math learning. (hint- you are already doing many of them!). After our brief math talk, families will go to classrooms to see where their children learn and play, meet teachers, have their children give a tour of the school and have some time for the playground. This is not an interview night to talk with teachers about student progress. This is a casual, relaxed night to visit the school. Parent/teacher interviews will be scheduled for later in October.

#### **Orange Shirt Day**

On September 29<sup>th</sup> Marysville participated in Orange Shirt Day, a national event. Orange Shirt Day grew out of Phyllis' story of having her shiny new orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the St. Joseph Mission (SJM) residential school, and it has become an opportunity to keep the discussion of residential schools happening annually. The date was chosen because it is the time of year in which children were taken from their homes to residential schools, and because it is an opportunity to set the stage for learning about anti-racism and anti-bullying.
