Cold Weather & Winter Clothes

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Winter is here! Please ensure that your child is adequately dressed when they arrive at school, particularly as we move into the colder winter months. Absence Reporting and Late

When calling or emailing to report your child's absence, please let us know if it's for illness or if it's parent excused. We do not need to know the details of the illness but would appreciate knowing if your child is home because they are sick or not.

If your child comes in to school <u>late</u>, please remind them to <u>check in at the office</u>. They will have been marked absent already. The first bell is at 8:15am so students have time to get ready and then class begins at 8:20am.

Indoor Shoes & Water Bottles

Please remember to send your child's inside shoes back to school. Running shoes are ideal for inside footwear as students can also use them in the gym. Please also be sure that they always have a full change of clothes that stays at their hook in case of any accidents or spills. As well, please remember to send a re-useable water bottle with your child every day.
