We appreciate greatly having this opportunity to write to you to express how much we all respect and admire your commitment to perpetuating Terry's legacy. This letter is just a small gesture on behalf of our family for the gratitude that we feel every year. We know Terry would never have imagined that more than 9,000 schools in Canada would host fundraisers in his name, including yours. We are so proud of the effort you are making to make our world a better place for everyone.

Our 2023 "Dear Terry" theme was an acknowledgement of the letters, cards, poems, songs and artwork - over 50,000 strong - forwarded to Terry after he was forced to stop running on September 1, 1980. The outpouring of love expressed in words and artform were the confirmation that Terry's message of hope and collaboration had been received in every nook and cranny of the country. Terry embraced them all, content that he had tried his very best and ready to accept his fate, knowing his run was now all of ours.

As a family we have always seen the Terry Fox Run as an extension of Terry's Marathon of Hope. Terry has never stopped running because of you.
